

Perfect Iced Coffee (The Pioneer Woman website)

Ingredients:

1 pound ground coffee: good, rich roast

8 quarts of cold filtered water

Directions:

In a large container, mix ground coffee with water. Cover and allow to sit at room temperature eight hours or overnight.

Line a fine mesh strainer with cheesecloth and set over a pitcher or other container. Pour coffee/water mixture through the strainer, allowing all liquid to run through. Discard grounds.

Place coffee liquid in the fridge and allow to cool. Use as needed.

To use, fill glass with ice and 2/3 full with coffee. Add milk or half & half and sugar or sweetened condensed milk to taste.



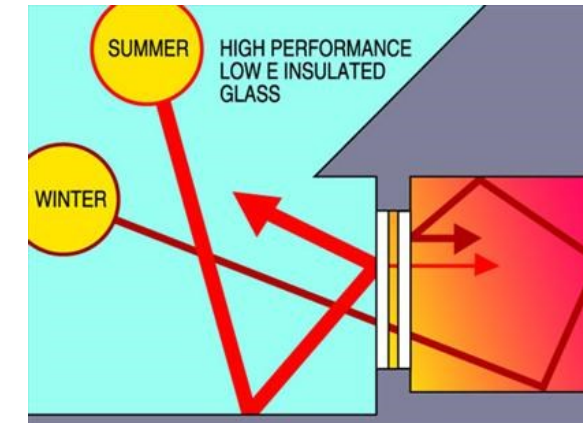
Window Education

Low-E glass features thin layers of anti-reflective metal oxide coatings applied to the surface. Homes stay cool in the summer by rejecting sunlight and warm in the winter by reflecting heat back into the home. It also greatly reduces fading from ultraviolet light so your furniture, drapes and carpet keep their color longer.

LoE 366 consists of two panes of insulated glass filled with argon. The inside of the exterior pane is coated with a triple layer of silver, providing a high level of solar control along with high visibility.

Dual Low-E glazing combines Cardinal LoE soft coat on the inside of the exterior pane (surface2) with Cardinal

i89 coating on the inside of the interior pane (surface 4). The Cardinal i89 coating is a durable, low emissivity coating that gives the product improved thermal insulation performance



compared to clear insulated glass or standard Low-E insulated glass.

TIP: How do you tell if your current windows are Low-E?

Stand next to your window on the inside of your home. Hold a flame next to the pane of glass. View at a slight angle. You have low-e glass if you see two flames.

5 Questions to ask your remodeler before your project starts

What is our schedule?

Ask about the lead times for the products you have picked. Also find out if the contractor has his own crew of employees. If he depends on subcontractors, he won't have the same control over the schedule. Find out how long they will need to be on the job site. Talk about the sequence of events so you'll know what days and times to expect the workers on site.

Who will be here every day?

Who will be on your property and who will be in charge. You should have a lead contractor or staff supervisor on the property in charge of the people and the project. This person will do a walk through with you at the end of the job and make sure you are happy with all the details within the scope of the contract.

How will you protect my property?

You have to break some eggs to make a cake so it's unrealistic to expect no dust or debris. A great remodeler has a plan to restrict the amount of dust and to clean up the dust and debris at the end of each work day. Each night before they leave, they should pick up their tools and supplies and clean up debris and dust so it won't continue to spread. When your project is complete, it is reasonable to expect they will remove all evidence of themselves. Only the finished product will remain.

How will you communicate with me?

If your idea of good communication is to have a report at the beginning and end of every day and your remodeler's idea is to show up to start and present a bill when he is done, you're going to both be disappointed. Ask in advance how often and in what form; phone, email or text, you can expect to hear from them so you will both have the same expectations.

What happens if there is a change order?

Every project is an opportunity for surprises. Talk about all possible issues or concerns with your remodeler in advance so you have a plan for the unexpected. A change order is the usual method for modifying your construction contract. A change order will affect your contract price as well as your schedule. It's best to get your change order in writing with the signatures of the client and the contractor.
